If you are interested, please reach out to the NWTDD's office for an application. Make sure you include copies of all the following with the completed application:

- ✓ Provide W-9
- ✓ Provide proof of Contractor's Public Liability insurance (\$100,000)
- ✓ Provide proof of Property Damage Insurance (\$100,000)
- ✓ Provide proof of workman's compensation
- ✓ Copy of current licenses, as applicable
- ✓ A completed application "Qualifications of the General Contractor."

Applications along with the required documentation will need to be turned in to the City or to the NWTDD office by: **Thursday, January 27th, 2026**. Once you have submitted all required documentation and your application is approved, you will be added to our **Qualified Contractor Listing**.

Being on this list ensures you are part of our procurement network. Our office will contact you directly regarding upcoming opportunities and provide specific notification of all relevant bid deadlines.
